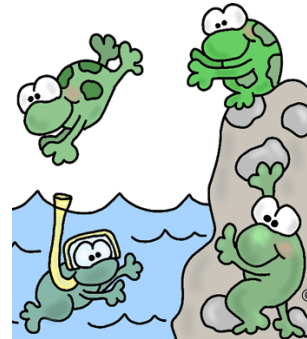

BIRTHDAY PARTIES AT THE POOLS!!!

Are you having a party and running out of ideas? Call the St. Charles Park Department today and have the "Party at the Pool." The Birthday Package includes admission to the pool, designated shaded area for two hours, hot dog lunch with chips and drink for 10 guests. Stay and play the rest of day. Parties are available at all three aquatic centers. The fee is \$80.00 for the group of ten, \$9 per person thereafter.

A private party of children 6 and under offers exclusive use of Blanchette or Wapelhorst Kiddie Pool after hours for up to 50 guests. You will have the area exclusively for 1 2 hours and a designated sitting area for \$125. A hotdog meal with chips and soda is an additional \$3.50 per person. Arrangements can be made at the Park Office by calling 949-3372.



GENERAL AQUATIC INFORMATION

***Certified Lifeguards** and First Aid Staff are on duty at all times for your comfort and safety.

***Persons MUST** be 48 inches tall to use any waterslide.

***Food**, drink, glass and coolers are not allowed into the Aquatic Centers. The Park Department reserves the right to check baggage if deemed appropriate.

***Incident Weather Policy:** The Blanchette, McNair and Wapelhorst Aquatic Centers will remain open except during threatening weather; such as thunderstorms, lightning, and tornadoes; **AND/OR** a minimum temperature of 72 degrees. During periods of low attendance various attractions and/or pools within the Aquatic Center may close.

***Rain Check Policy:** Rain checks will only be issued to patrons when the aquatic centers are opened but close by 3 pm on a given day. **BEFORE** closing the aquatic centers, a 30 minute wait will take place to make sure the threatening weather will not pass. You **MUST** have your receipt to receive the rain check. Rain checks will be issued at the cashier booth.

***Step through inner tubes with leg openings are not allowed and there can not be any exceptions.**

***The Aquatic Centers** are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

***The Aquatic Centers** can not allow the paging of pool patrons. Please make communicative arrangements prior to entering.

***Smoking is not** permitted inside the aquatic centers. Violators will be asked to leave as this is a safety issue.

***Any person** under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be permitted to enter.

***It is the** responsibility of patrons when entering the facility to read and obey all the posted signs for their safety.

***Use of the** Season Pass card by persons other than the person (s) listed on the season membership will result in a cancellation of the pass.

For your convenience all season passes & swim lessons may be completed through the mail. Fill out the enclosed registration form and send us a copy of your property tax receipt and a current utility bill to verify residency. Season pass cards will require in person registration after May 9. For more information contact the Park Office at 949-3372.

CONCESSION STANDS/PICNICKING

All three concession stands offer concession items for sale. Pool patrons are allowed to leave the aquatic centers to picnic; just get your hand stamped at the cashier booth.

DIRECTIONS for I-70

Blanchette Aquatic Center is located at 1900 W. Randolph. Take First Capitol Drive North to Kingshighway (Lindenwood College). Go left onto Kingshighway until it dead ends, turn left onto W. Randolph. Turn right at the first stop sign (Pine Street) into the Park.

McNair Aquatic Center is located at 3200 Droste Road. Take First Capitol North, turn left onto West Clay (water tower). Take an immediate right at the stop light onto Droste. Follow Droste for one mile to McNair Park, the entrance is on your right.

Wapelhorst Aquatic Center is located at 1874 Muegge Road. Take First Capitol Drive South, changes to Hwy 94 South. Exit Right at Pralle Lane, take the first left (Old Hwy 94), then turn right onto Muegge Road. Go one mile, park is on your left.

Children 11 and under MUST be supervised at all times by persons 14 years of age or older.

PARK PASSPORT CARD

Formerly the called the VIP card, this card is available to City of St. Charles residents only and offers discounts on selected Parks programs and at selected area businesses. There is no charge for the Park Passport. City residents purchasing pool passes will automatically receive their Park Passport Cards unless you check the NO box on the pass form. All others will need proof of residency and two forms of ID is required; either your 2007 property tax receipt, utility bill and/or driver=s license are all acceptable means of ID. Cards may be obtained at the Parks office from 8 am until 4:30 pm Monday through Friday.

The minimum age to enter the aquatic center without someone 14 years of age or older is 12 years of age.

The St. Charles Parks Department has teamed up with The Missouri Alliance for Animal Legislation, which is a non-profit organization founded in 1990 lobbying exclusively for animal welfare issues in Missouri. This event is offered to all dogs and of course their owners too, to participate in the end of season pool swim. The first event will be held at **McNair Aquatic Center on Monday, August 3 from 6-8 pm.** **The second event will be Thursday, August 6 from 6-8pm.**

Fees for either event is \$10 for the dog and owner and \$3 additional for each guest.

RULES:

All dogs must wear an I.D. tag and be on a leash unless swimming
All current vaccination records, including DHLPP and rabies are required to swim.
NO Children under the age of 8.
All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent.
All humans must sign a waiver.
