Dogs Have Different Play Styles

Educate yourself about dog behavior. Behavior that concerns some dog owners may simply be a rambunctious play style. Always respect other dog owners' wishes if they are not comfortable with how your dog is interacting with theirs. Leash up and leave if your dog is acting in an aggressive manner or having a bad day.



Keep Walking

Walking defuses defensive behaviors and helps keeps the off-leash area a neutral territory. Limit the time you spend standing and chatting.



Know your Dog

Not all dogs like meeting new dogs. If your dog has not regularly interacted with other dogs, find out how he will react before forcing him to meet lots of unfamiliar dogs.



Closely Supervise Your Dog

Do not reach in to break up fighting dogs. Instead, squirt the dogs in the face with your water bottle or distract the dogs by throwing a jacket on them. If it is your own dog, try grabbing its tail.



Prevent Injuries

Under Missouri law, a dog owner is liable for injuries and damage inflicted by their dog. Watch your dog carefully! If your dog injures a dog, give your contact information to the injured party. Report to the Ranger Division any handlers who refuse to take responsibility for damages/injuries and who are endangering the safety of others. Record their license plate number if possible.

We highly recommend each Visitor become familiar with the rules of the facility. These rules have been adopted by the Parks and Recreation Board to help ensure the best visit possible to the off-leash facility.

This 2.5 acre facility has an area for large dogs and small dogs. Please pay attention to the signs on the gates because the areas will be rotated as necessary to help keep the Park green. As the dog owner, it is your responsibility to determine your dogs' nature and abilities when playing at the Park.

This new facility adds another highlight to an already extensive system of recreational opportunities for all to enjoy! These are your Parks, help keep them clean!

DuSable Dog Park Rules

These Rules have been adopted by the Parks and Recreation Board to ensure an enjoyable visit by everyone!

- Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by their dogs
- No aggressive dogs
- All dogs must be spayed or neutered
- No puppies under 4 months of age
- No animals other than dogs
- No ill or injured dogs
- No food, dog treats, rawhide, or glass containers
- Limit of three dogs per person in the off-leash area
- Pinch, spike and choke collars must be removed prior to entering the fenced off-leash area
- No children under the age of 8
- Owners must clean up after their dogs
- Dogs must remain on a leash while entering and exiting the dog park
- Owners must carry a leash at all times and closely supervise their dogs
- Dogs must be under voice control at all times
- Never leave your dogs unattended
- Owners must be prepared to show license and immunization records
- Owners must stop dogs from digging and must fill any holes caused by their dogs
- Professional trainers may not use off-leash area for conduct of their business without approval
- No climbing on or over the fence
- No bicycles, skateboards, roller skates or blades, or any motorized devices except wheelchairs
