

"LEWIS & CLARK MONUMENT"

The Louisiana Territory was officially transferred to the United States in the spring of 1804. On May 14th, Clark set out with a restless, rowdy, high spirited crew of 43 men, moving up the muddy, Missouri River. They arrived in St. Charles two days later and camped, awaiting the arrival of Capt. Lewis and his Newfoundland Dog Seaman.

Wednesday May the 16th 1804

"...at 12oClock a number Spectators french & Indians flocked to the bank to See the party. This Village is about one mile in length...and about 450 inhabitents chiefly French, those people appear pore, polite & harmonious.
