**Itinerary**

Dear Parks & Recreation Traveler:

We are very excited to finally have the information for our “**Christmas in Branson**” tour available for our travelers. Christmas lights abound as we enjoy the festive atmosphere of Christmas in the Ozarks. Highlight of the tour will be an evening cruise on the Branson Belle to include dinner & show on pristine Table Rock Lake. Also scheduled are “*The Twelve Irish Tenors Holiday Show*”, “*Six Show*,” “*Red, Hot & Blue Show*” and “*The Spirit of Christmas Show*” as well as a visit to the ever-popular “*Titanic Museum*”. A holiday “*Christmas Lights Drive Through*” is planned and plenty of time to do that last minute Christmas shopping. As always this itinerary is subject to change without advance notice.

The tour will include 3 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 3 dinners, 3 attractions, showboat, admissions, Christmas Lights, lodging, baggage handling, gratuities, escort & chartered motor coach transportation. As you read further, we think you will agree this trip will be a great one.

**Participants** should be aware that this trip will include moderate walking with some periods of standing. Travelers will be negotiating some stairs during portions of the trip.

**Participants** will be restricted to one piece of checked luggage and one carryon bag to be carried inside the motor coach. Luggage tags & final itinerary will be provided closer to the actual departure date of the trip.

**Participants** who register must also complete a consent waiver form which will detail emergency contacts and any current and pertinent medical or medicinal information. This form will be sent at a later date.

The cost of the trip will be **\$599** per person (double occupancy). The single traveler supplement will be **\$125** for a total cost of **\$724** per single traveler. The triple occupancy rate will be **\$564** per person.  
**Deposit:** \$50 per person deposit (non-refundable). Final payment is due by November 3, 2010.

**TRAVEL INSURANCE:** Many of you have inquired about travel insurance for our extended trips.
