The cost of the trip will be **\$299** per person (double occupancy). The single traveler supplement will be **\$45** for a total cost of **\$344** per single traveler. The triple cost is **\$284** per person (triple occupancy).

Deposit: \$50 (non-refundable). Final payment is due by August 30, 2010. Anyone cancelling after August 30, 2010 is not eligible for a refund.
