USE

- Skateboards, Roller Skates and In-line Skates Only.
- The Skate Facility Will Be Open from 10 A.m. to Dusk.
- “No Trespassing” Will Be Enforced after the Park Is Closed.

SAFETY

- The Skate Park Is a Skate at Your Own Risk Facility.
- This Is a Non-Supervised Facility
- Skateboarding and In-line Skating Is a “High Risk Activity”.
- Wearing a Helmet, Knee Pads, Elbow Pads and Wrist Guards Is Strongly Recommended at All Times.
- Know Your Ability and Skate Accordingly.
- Inspect the Surfaces Before You Ride Them. Remove All Trash, Debris and Objects That May Prevent a Smooth, Safe Ride.
- No Other Items Such as Benches, Tables, Wood Materials, or Other Objects Are Allowed in the Skate Park Facility.

PLEASE REMEMBER

- No Bicycles, Motorized Vehicles, or Other Wheeled Devices Allowed Within the Skate Park.
- Graffiti in the Skate Facility Is Illegal and Will Not Be Tolerated.
- Keep the Skating Surfaces Clean.
- Graffiti or Trash Will Close the Facility down for Removal.
- This Skate Facility Has Been Designed for All Skill Levels.
- No Competitive or Demonstration Events Are Allowed Without Prior Approval from the Park Department.
- No Glass Containers, Food or Beverages Allowed in the Fenced Area.
- This Is an Alcohol, Tobacco and Drug Free Area.
- No Pets Allowed.
- Be Courteous to Other People Using the Facility and All Other Park Patrons. (Language, Music & Actions)
