## 3. Discussion of Aquatics Comprehensive Plan

Director Britton went through the information that was in the packet given to the Board Members. Included were the survey (s), attendance figures, election dates and passage requirements, bond information, estimated timelines and the final implementation scenario options. Each board member had time to ask any questions and explain which option they preferred.

General consensus of the Members was to recommend option 2, renovation of Wapelhorst outdoor facility and building a new indoor/outdoor facility at Blanchette.

Britton was given direction from the Board to draft a resolution for discussion and adoption at the June 17<sup>th</sup> Park Board meeting that would recommend requesting the renovation of Wapelhorst Aquatic Facility, replace Blanchette Aquatic Facility with an indoor and outdoor component and allow McNair Aquatic Facility to remain open until the expense of repairs become no longer feasible. The recommendation would also be to request the ballot proposal to be placed on the November 8, 2016 ballot. With an extended period of time between the current estimates and potential beginning of construction, costs will be reviewed with the consultants for inflation which would be included within the resolution.

The Resolution would be presented to Mayor Faith and City Council at the next Joint Work Session on July 14, 2015 at 7pm in Council Chambers of City Hall.

## 4. Adopt a Park.

Lanning: Asked about the rock at Booneslick Park. Staff said it was where the new ½ basketball court would go.

Ryan: Asked about cutting Boschert Trial. Staff said it was completed today.

Barro: Blanchette looked good.

Slattery: Good.
