SKATE BOARD FACILITY

USE

- Skateboards, Roller Skates and In-Line Skates Only.
- The Skate Facility will be open from Dawn – to Dusk.
- “No Trespassing” will be enforced after the park is closed.

SAFETY

- The Skate Park is a “Skate at your own risk” facility.
- This is non-supervised facility.
- Skateboarding and In-Line skating is a “High Risk Activity”.
- Wearing a helmet, knee pads, elbow pads and wrist guards is strongly recommended at all times.
- Know your ability and skate accordingly.
- Inspect the surfaces before you ride them. Remove all trash, debris and objects that may prevent a smooth safe ride.
- No other items such as benches, tables, wood materials or other objects are allowed in the Skate Park Facility.

PLEASE REMEMBER

- No bicycles, motorized vehicles, or other wheeled devices allowed within the skate park.
- Graffiti and vandalism in the facility is illegal and will not be tolerated.
- Keep the skating surfaces clean.
- Graffiti, vandalism and excessive trash will close the facility down for removal.
- The facility has been designed for all skill levels.
- No competitive or demonstration events are allowed without prior approval from the Parks & Recreation Department.
- No glass containers, food or beverages allowed in the fenced area.
- This is an alcohol, tobacco and drug free area.
- No pets allowed.
- Be courteous to other people using the facility and all other patrons (language, music & actions).
- Report maintenance concerns to (636) 949 – 3372. Office is open Monday – Friday from 8:00am – 5:00pm.
