Dear Parks & Recreation Traveler:

We are very excited to finally have the information for our “*Country Christmas in Nashville*” tour available for our travelers. Christmas lights abound as we make our first Christmas trip to Nashville, TN. Our lodging will be in the *Gaylord Opryland Resort & Convention Center*. Highlights of the tour will be a visit to the *Grand Ole Opry House*, *Country Music Hall of Fame*, *RCA Studio B* and a Lunch Cruise on the *General Jackson Showboat*. As always, this itinerary is subject to change without advance notice.

Wednesday, we check in to the Opryland Resort for a three-night stay. We enjoy their 9 amazing acres of indoor gardens, cascading waterfalls and indoor river and marvel at more than 3 million holiday lights and acres of magnificent decorations. This evening take time to explore this amazing facility at your leisure.

On Thursday we board the *General Jackson Showboat* for a lunch cruise that will also include a Christmas Show. This evening we enjoy the legendary *Oak Ridge Boys* “Christmas in Tennessee” Dinner Show in one of the resorts main Ball Rooms.

Friday, we visit the legendary *RCA Studio B* and visit the *Country Music Hall of Fame*. After lunch we join an insider tour guide for an exclusive backstage tour of the *Grand Ole Opry House* and get an intimate look at the people, places, and stories behind the show that made country music famous. This evening we sit back and enjoy the show that made country music famous—*The Grand Ole Opry!*

The tour will include 2 Lunches, 1 dinner, all attractions, admissions, evening dinner & show, lodging, baggage handling, gratuities, escort & chartered motor coach transportation. As you read further, we think you will agree this trip will be a great one.

Participants will be restricted to one piece of checked luggage and one carryon bag to be carried inside the motor coach. Luggage tags & final itinerary will be mailed closer to the actual departure date.

Participants who register must also complete a consent waiver form which will detail emergency contacts and any current and pertinent medical or medicinal information. This form will be sent at a later date.

The cost of the trip will be **\$1050** per person (double occupancy). The single traveler supplement will be **\$280** for a total cost of **\$1330** per single traveler. The triple occupancy rate will be **\$955** per person.

Deposit: **\$50** per person deposit (non-refundable).

Friday, June 25: an additional amount of **\$500** must be paid.

Friday, October 1, 2021: Final payment is due

Friday, October 1, 2021: After this date no refunds of any kind will be given for cancellations due to our commitment to the various vendors involved with this trip (see the information on travel insurance, highly recommended).

This trip will close out for traveler sign-up on Friday, October 1, 2021
